Studying at EURECOM

FLEXIBLE COURSE STRUCTURE

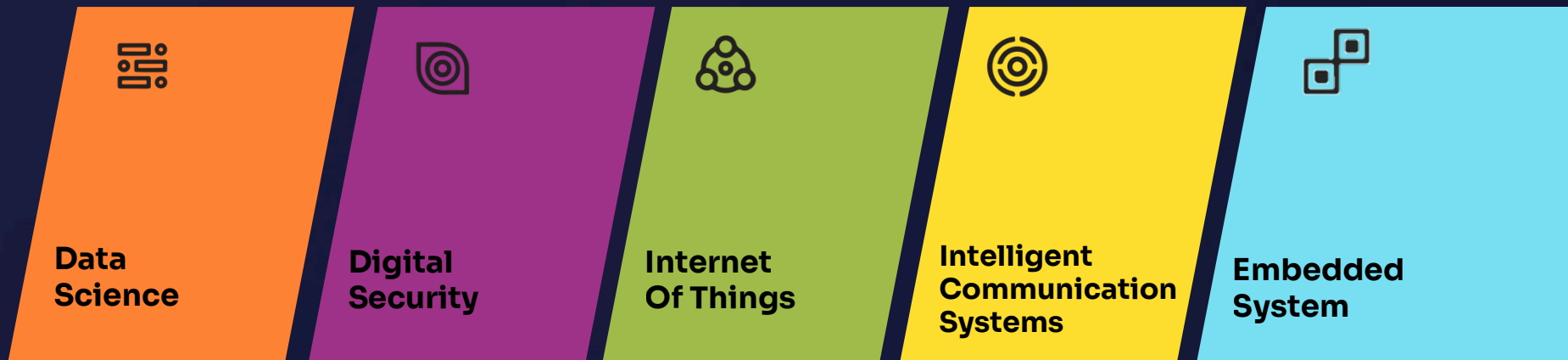
EURECOM is an engineering school offering graduate programs with **flexible entry points**. Students can join after a Bachelor's level for a three-year program or a Master's level for a two-year program.

- **Course choice:** Students select courses according to their home university rules
- **Duration:** 1–4 semesters, depending on the agreement with the home university
- **Level:** Bachelor's (Year 3) & Master's (Years 4–5)
- **Guidance:** Curriculum organized into 5 study tracks to help course selection

Final schedules are released a few days before the academic year.

LANGUAGE & INTEGRATION

- Courses are **100% in English**
- **Optional FLE (French as a Foreign Language)** courses help students integrate culturally and linguistically
- **Students with French < A2** or without official proficiency may be required to attend the intensive FLE program

FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROGRAM (FLE)

Intensive Course (Fall intake only)

- **60-hour** French course starting in early September
- Designed to support academic, cultural, and daily life integration at EURECOM

Who should attend?

- Mandatory for students with French level below A2 or without official certification

Exemptions

- Possible with a valid CEFR-based certificate (last 2 years)
- Request to be submitted before July 1st via admission@eurecom.fr

Important Notes

- Not available for Spring intake
- Weekly FLE courses available during the academic year (Fall & Spring)
- Exemption applies only to the intensive program; an official French certificate remains required for graduation

CVEC FEE

Mandatory government fee CVEC (Student & Campus Life Contribution)

- Applies to all degree-seeking students (including double degrees) except exchange students
 - Paid once per academic year
 - Required to complete your registration
 - A certificate is issued after payment and must be submitted

TUITION FEES

Tuition fees according to agreement.
Not applied to exchange students.

PAYMENT PLAN

To facilitate tuition payments, EURECOM offers an installment plan under the following conditions:

- Split into **six monthly payments** (Oct, Nov, Dec, Mar, Apr, May)

Annual management fee:

- €100 if total installments
- ≥ €3,500; €50 if less
- SEPA direct debit only (Single Euro Payments Area, a secure EU-wide payment system).

Installment plan offered after admission confirmation and activated via a dedicated form.

Admission

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Certificates must be valid at the time of application and meet the required level for admission.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Official test score (TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, Cambridge) or **school certificate** indicating level

Double-degree students: level requirements may differ for graduation

FRENCH PROFICIENCY

Official test score (DELFL, TFI, DCL FLE, DALF, TCF) or **school certificate** indicating level

Not required for **exchange students**

Double-degree students:

- May require a higher level for graduation
- Minimum A1 required for:
 - Post-Master's Degree
 - Engineering Degree (intake Year 2)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **Bachelor's degree** (min. 2 years) in computer science, computer engineering, IT, applied mathematics, or equivalent (*depending on the chosen program*)
- **Strong foundations in mathematics**
- **Good programming skills** (e.g., R, Python, Java)
- Excellent academic performance (high GPA and grades in key courses)
- **Good academic performance**
- Clear **expectations to join EURECOM:** career aspirations, relevant experience, and motivation
- **Language skills in English** and in French (for DD only)
- Ability to clearly express reasons for applying and why they would excel in the program
- **Additional relevant experience is highly valued** (work, research, entrepreneurship, competition success)

APPLICATION PROCESS

STEP 1: Selection process at home institution

STEP 3: Once nominated, student will receive **access to EURECOM's Application Portal**. **Evaluation and final decision** is made by EURECOM (admitted/rejected)

STEP 5: Arrival Preparation

Fall semester 26 (Intake in Sep26): **15 May 2026**
Spring semester 27 (Intake in March27): **15 November 2026**

MISSING DOCUMENTS

To confirm your enrollment, send any missing documents listed in your admission package **by September 15** to admission@eurecom.fr

- Failure to provide them may result in cancellation of your admission.

REGISTRATION

The registration period runs from July 1 to September 15, 2026 (to be confirmed). You will need to upload:

- Valid **passport**
- Long-stay student visa or "titre de séjour" (if applicable) and its validation
- CVEC payment certificate
- Proof of health insurance (private or European Health Insurance Card)
- Proof of personal liability coverage

DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST

- **CV**
- Copy of valid **ID / passport**
- **Statement of purpose / motivation letter**
- Official **transcript of records** in English
- A recent passport-style **picture**
- **English Language Certificate** or a letter written by the university stating that the student has the required proficiency in English (B2)
- **2 recommendation letters** (for DD only)





Living in France

HOUSING

Finding accommodation for housing on the French Riviera can be challenging, so students should start early

- **Recommended timeline** : June (Fall intake), December (Spring intake)
- **Average rent**: 400-800€/month
- Platforms: Studapart, CROUS

Support:

- Housing assistance (CAF)
- Guidance from student services
- A limited number of CROUS rooms is available through EURECOM (subject to selection)

HEALTH INSURANCE

EU STUDENTS: Citizens of EU Member States, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, or Switzerland are not required to enroll in the French National Healthcare if they have an European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). The EHIC must be valid until the end of their stay.

NON-EU STUDENTS: Enrollment to the French National Healthcare known as “Sécurité Sociale” is free and mandatory. This will allow students to benefit from partial refund on healthcare expenses, on average 70%. All the registration process is done online once visa is obtained.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

EU STUDENTS: Citizens of EU Member States, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, or Switzerland do not need a visa for France.

NON-EU STUDENTS: Must apply for a long-stay student visa (4 months to one year). They need a student residence permit to stay in France for the duration of their studies and must apply for an extended-stay visa with a residency permit at the nearest French consulate.

Financial Requirement: For visa insurance, French authorities require financial guarantee of 615€ per month (7380€ per year)
